Administrative/Biographical History:

Joseph Tweedy, the son of Oliver Burr Tweedy and Maria (Lord) Tweedy, was born 17 March 1849. Tweedy was educated in the public schools in New York City, private college and business college. Until 1870, he worked as a tea taster for a large New York firm. He moved to Plainfield, New Jersey, where he remained until 1876 when he and partners JB. Reynolds and E.M. Grinnell arrived in Texas.

The three men sailed to Galveston with the intention to make their fortune in the sheep and wool industry. From there they traveled by train to Kingsbury, Texas, at the end of the railroad; then by stage to San Antonio; and on to the area between Fort Clark and Eagle Pass. The trio remained in that region for almost a year. Frequent Indian depredations caused them to seek a safer country.

In 1877, the men moved their flock of sheep to the Concho Valley. For one cent an acre, the men leased twenty thousand acres, and according to County Clerk, John Lackey, they were the first to lease land in the area. Upon their arrival, the trio lived in a tent camp. They kept their provisions in one tent and slept in another. They spent their evenings reading novels and writing letters home by lantern light. Many of these letters, along with diaries kept during this time, are housed in the West Texas Collection.

Tweedy is credited with having founded the community of Knickerbocker, Texas, named after one of Washington Irving's characters. The first ranch house was a thatched adobe shack papered with copies of *Harper's Weekly*.

There was little demand for mutton in those days. They sold their animals for \$1.00-1.50 per head to anyone who would buy them. Wool had to be hauled to San Antonio in ox carts. Typically, the wool sold for twenty-five to thirty cents a pound, but declining wool prices, at one time dropping to six cents a pound, led the partnership to dissolve in 1884 . J.B. Reynolds went to Omaha, Nebraska, and became a general agent for a railroad. Grinnell returned to New York City, but Joseph Tweedy remained in Tom Green County.

In 1881, Tweedy was elected the president for the first Wool Growers Association in this area. He also helped start the San Jose Irrigation Company, was involved in mining in the Lajitas area of the Big Bend, and operated the general store in Knickerbocker.

Tweedy returned to New York and married Elizabeth Melleck. The couple reared four children. Tweedy died 7 January 1928.

Scope and Content:

The Tweedy Family Papers consists of 51 boxes of personal and business papers, diaries, correspondence, store ledgers, deeds and other legal documents, and seven books and periodicals. In addition, a moderate number of photographs and newspaper clippings are included.

Arrangement:

The records are arranged in five series, outlined below.

Series I. Correspondence, 1822-1929 (18 boxes)

This series consists of letters written by the three young men, Tweedy, Grinnell, and Reynolds, as well as letters written to them by friends and family. There are also some letters written to the Tweedy sisters. The letters are arranged chronologically.

Series II. Legal and Financial Papers, 1813-1927 (23 boxes)

This series consists of legal and financial papers of the Tweedy family. Most of the documents are concerned with the purchase of items by the Tweedys. The papers are arranged chronologically. Also included is Tweedy's work with the Republican Party.

Series III. Diaries and Transcribed Letters, 1876-1923 (5 boxes)

This series consists of diaries kept by Joseph Tweedy, E.M. Grinnell, and Isabel Tweedy. Those of Miss Tweedy were written while in Europe.

Series IV. Oil, Gas and Irrigation Papers (2 boxes)

This series consists of documents relating to the establishment of the San Jose Irrigation and Power Company as well as the leasing of land for oil and gas well drilling.

Series V. Business Ledgers from the Knickerbocker Store (3 boxes)

This series consists of business ledgers from the Knickerbocker Store owned and operated by Tweedy.
