## Administrative/Biographical History:

J.B. Morris was born on 31 December 1914, in Dallas, Texas. He came to West Texas to work on the University of Texas Land Survey and later worked with the Big Lake Oil Company. He also served two years in the United States Army during World War II.

In 1944, he became District Executive of the Concho Valley Council Boy Scouts of America, serving in Del Rio and San Angelo. During that time he collected a number of early San Angelo BSA history, including role sheets, pictures, and stories. He received two of the highest awards in scouting during his lifetime, the Silver Beaver and the Good Shepherd.

Morris continued to have an interest in and a passion for scouting until his death on 11 November 1986. His materials were collected by Frank Hilton, who used the materials in writing his book on the history of scouting in this region.

# **Scope and Content:**

This collection consists of newspapers, newspaper clippings, interviews, photographs, manuals, guides and scouting memorabilia.
