Dear Mother,

After I had written to you Wednesday one of the fellows brought the package you sent in. I was very glad to get it. Thanks a lot for everything.

Yesterday was my day off and if you have received my other letter you know where I went. I took the film in but it was not a very nice day so we didn't take any pictures. It will probably be about the 22nd before we do take them. I have another picture of Jean and I to sent [sic] when they are developed.

The mail has not came [sic] today so I still may get some letters. Yesterday yours of the 28th of June came.
