Dear Mama,

I received your letter dated July 8 yesterday. It was the first I had got in about two weeks.

I tried for half an hour to write J.R. but I couldn't think of any thing to say so I just stopped. you asked about eggs and milk well we have both but they are powdered and not very good.

I go ~~th~~ to church at the ~~Chaple~~ Chaple every Sunday

The Chaplain is a little short  
major named Appellton.

I went to town last night  
and went to a band concert  
down in the park but it wasn't  
very good.

We have Winter, Spring, Summer  
and Fall ever week.

I have saved about \$120<sup>00</sup> in  
the last eight months besides  
what I sent home. I have  
it in the safe at the Red  
Cross Club.

Some of the fellows are getting  
seven day parlours but I don't  
think I will try to get one yet.  
Well I got to stop now and go to  
bed.
