Dear Mama,

I haven't heard from you yet but I may get a letter today sometime. I got \$8.40 ration money yesterday.

It rained here a little daybefore [sic] yesterday and it's not so hot as it was or it wasn't yesterday.

I still don't know when we are going to leave here but everything is packed and I don't thank [sic] it will be long but they are giving furloughs out on the 3rd and 6th of next month.

Well I don't have much time for writing because I want to get this in the mail today. I write when I learn some news.
