Dear Mother,

Your letter of 22nd, 23rd and 27th of May come today. I was very glad to receive them ~~expect~~ except it made me mad getting the one of 22nd with the ..... of support from you in it when it could have come the other day when Jean was here instead of the one of the 24th. Now she will have to make another trip to London. Don't get me wrong mother, I am not mad at you. You couldn't be helping me out any more than you already are.

[page 2] I do not know how I will be coming back when I come. I would like to fly back and had hopes of it once but now I imagine it will be by ship. Not too soon though.

No I don't have any idea when I will make second class as the rate is closed.

Where is Daddy going to be night watchman. [sic] It will be at home won't it or I hope so anyway. Who is going to take his place at the well.

There is no need for you to send any more packages as I don't know of anything I need. Be saving up some 616 film for me please. By the time I come you should have several rolls.
