Dear Mother,

Last year this time Jean and I were in London having lots of fun. I received the letter which had the one for the Chaplian [sic] in it. I'll give it to him the first chance that I have to see him. Thanks for the picture mother. I'm always glad to get pictures. The photographer who sleeps in our hut has promised to take some good pictures of the wedding.

Jean and I plan to get married about the 5th of June. If I can get a 48hr pass [page 2] that day and the next. Then in a week or so I may be able to get five days leave which we will spend in Ilfracombe. She has had her hair fixed and she really looks nice. Mother, she thinks that you may be a little angry at her because I'm staying here. She didn't know I put in for the extension so don't be angry with her. Last night was my liberty night and I hadn't told her I was coming in because I didn't think I could get off in time, she was waiting for me though.
