Dear Mama,

I got a letter from Gertrude written May 24 yesterday and one written a few days sooner a few days ago. I got another letter from Robert.

I lost J.R.'s address before I got to write him. I don't have anyplace to keep letters. Try to get a later address for Howary Watkins. The one you sent was the address he had when he was here. He should have a new APO number.

We have been in England over six months now and have been at the same place all the time. We had a chicken dinner at the Red Cross club in town on the night of the first of June.

It doesn't get dark until about 11:30 o'clock and is getting light again by 4:30 the next morning.

I got an invitation to attend Richard's Commencement exercise but I couldn't go because I got it two days late.

It is 9:20 now so I think I will stop and go to bed. It's still daylight but I can't wait for dark.
