I got your letter today. It was the first one I've had in a long time. No one has got any mail from Mendocuer. I don't know why they don't send it up but they don't.

I may go some place in Ibeva when I leave here or maybe to Mantoroa I don't know which... I think me

will go across in
November. No one knows
where we will go
to.

Send me Roberts address
when you get it.

We are going to learn
to use a gun.

I hope to get a
higher ~~Rating~~ rank soon
but don't count too
much on it. When
I go across I will
get a 20% increase in
pay. We may go to
South America or Ireland
but no one knows
where we will go

yet. Not even the Major.
 The wind sure has been
 blowing here today
 and the dust is awful.
 I wish Omas had
 at Mendocino.

I don't write much
 because there isn't
 much to write.

I guess you have
 heard of the Snake
 River we will meet
 along beside it for
 miles coming up here.
 It sure was pretty
 and wide.

Well I guess I had
