Administrative/Biographical History:

The Concho Valley Electric Cooperative was organized in May 1940 as a non-profit organization, owned by the members. The first General Manager was Carroll Land. The first meter was energized in July 1941 and was located 2 ³/₄ miles south of Veribest.

Today the cooperative serves over 4,400 members and has 3,606 miles of line covering 4,175 square miles in ten counties: Tom Green, Coke, Concho, Sterling, Mitchell, Nolan, Runnels, Glasscock, Irion and Reagan.

Scope and Content:

Collection includes the periodical of the Concho Valley Electric Co-op located in San Angelo, TX. The periodical is in newspaper format and includes a variety of material on agriculture, regional and state history, and political issues that affected this area. Periodicals are not indexed.
