I haven't been writing many letters because there isn't much to say and what I can think of the censor would not let pass. I have been to town several times now. It is a fair size town and I think it is a very nice town. I wish I could tell you the name and where it is but all I can say is that it is in England and I have told you that before. The people here are very friendly I haven't seen the town in a day time but once so I don't know much what it looks like. I hope you will be able to read this letter. Maby Gertrude will read it to you. Send more Vmail. They have been known to get here in ten days.

If you want to send me something I could use a good flashlight. Be sure to get one with standard size batteries and not over two cell.

I guess you noticed the change in my APO address and I am no longer in the 42 group. It rains here ever day or two but it has n't been so very cold yet. It did snow here a while back but it soon melted.

The chow over here is better than I thought it would be but there is no milk and that's what I miss most. I got in the habit of buying two or three milkshakes a day so I sure miss them. I can't go the tea they have here.

I can't think of much more to say so I guess I will close for this time. Write as often as you can.
