October 13, 1942

Dear Mother

I received your letter today, but I haven't received the package or the card that you sent me. When do you suppose that my pictures will be here? I do not know why my letters haven't reached you. I have written you several since the first one.

My address is Farragut (RR), not Fanagut.

Aunt Annie wrote to me she sent me some pictures that she took of Jackie, Tommie and I. They are good pictures. I finally received Jean's letter yesterday. She wants a picture of me in my uniform but I do not know when I can have any made. The swimming pool is completed now but I haven't been swimming. Last night I went to a show at Camp [illegible]. It was 'all [page 2] that money can buy.' The recreation hall is open but I am still on K.P. and do not know when I will get a chance to go there.

Today everybody is learning how to roll their clothes. I haven't rolled mine because there is not enough room. I need to wash some clothes too, but the wash room is out of order.
