I got payed today for last month. I drew \$65.28. I am sending \$20.00 home. I would send more but I don't know when I will get payed again.

We are suppose to leave here in about two weeks. I think we will go to Washington and pick up more men then but I don't think we will stay there long. We may go back East after we leave there but noone knows where we will go. I don't look for a boat ride for several months. I sure will be glad to leave here. I will send more next time I get payed and will try to send more.
