Angelo boxer Luna ranked 5th in nation

GULFPORT, Miss. - Jesse Luna of San Angelo has earned a No. 5 ranking nationally in USA Boxing after splitting a pair of matches earlier this month at the 19-and-Under National Boxing Championships.

Luna earned his ranking in the 112-pound division after beating Michael Alzanos of Oklahoma in his first bout before dropping a decision in his next fight.

Members of the Luna Boxing Club also competed in the Texas Games in late July in Lubbock.

Christopher Ellingburg, a 13-year-old, won the 138-pound division in a walkover, while 15-year-old Jaime Gonzales did the same in the 90-pound division.
