I done about the same thing yesterday as I always do on Sunday. I couldn't do much different with out a car or ~~something~~ anyway to get around.

Nearly a third of the class I'm in have washed back due to sickness or some other cause.

The hay is one of those pictures I sent home in ~~in~~ in the ~~hospital~~ <sup>hospital</sup> now.

I dread getting out of school but I'll be glad when I do and see where I go. I guess waiting will be the worse part of it or I hope it will be.

I would write more but I don't know a thing to write.
