December 3, 1945

Dear Daddy,

Today is Sunday. I did not go to church because I was on work detail.

Friday I went to Spokane. The stores were closed when I got there and I could not buy any christmas presents as I wanted to.

Last night I went to a show at Camp Hill. It was "Broadway."

Yesterday morning I worked in the selection office at Camp Ward [page 2] grading papers for Mr. Smith.

I do not know anything about what school or when I am going. Some of the boys are leaving in the morning. The boys from company 15 that went home on leave got back today. I hope to know something next week.

Tonight I may go to a show at Camp Ward.

Did you get the Christmas card that I sent you the other day?

[page 3] Thursday night I was on the garage detail. I had to wash busses and the captians [sic] car and station wagon.

Are you going to get a vacation christmas?

There was about a foot of snow on the ground but most of it is melting. Is it sloppy outside. [sic] Last night is [sic] rained a little bit.

It is almost time for chow so I will quit.
