Dear Mother,

The latest date on your letters that I have received was August 19th so that is not bad.

Last night the Fabens boy said that he would go down and see you for me. I do not know just how soon it will be. He will have thirty days leave though, and it will be sometime during that time.

[page 2] Another wasp has stung Jean on the side of the face. Tomorrow I will get to see her.

So Betty has Dan Patch in town. I suppose she will be using my saddle. It will do it good and Dan Patch too. Take some pictures if you can.

I [sic] sorry I have not said much in this letter but I have three more to answer and I don't feel much like writing.
