

# Abilene Man Is Killed In Tokyo Crash

A former airman at Goodfellow Air Force Base was among the 129 killed in the C124 crash near Tokyo Thursday, the Defense Department announced Friday.

He is Lt. Mac Lee Fitzgerald, who underwent basic training at Goodfellow. Lt. Fitzgerald is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Delmar Fitzgerald and the husband of Mrs. Joyce Fitzgerald, all of Abilene.

It is believed he was expected to return home in six weeks to his wife and to his baby son whom he had never seen.

Lt. Fitzgerald was a graduate of Joe M. Hart High School in Abilene and attended Abilene Christian College. He enlisted in the Air Force at Abilene and later graduated from the basic multi-engine flying school at Reese Air Force Base, Lubbock.
