October 6, 1944. Eldorado, Texas

Dear Brother: We have been told to write very simply and omit all slang, so I will try to do so, however hard that may be. Oh, it is very wonderful to be able to write to you again after all these long weeks. Everyone here is fine as can be and Lonnie is walking everywhere. He is a fine boy. They came down to see us for a few days not long ago and have promised to come back again when you come home....oh, happy day! Jack and went to San Antonio last week end and met James over there. We had a good time and James is fine. He still lives at _____ San Marcos. Calvin is going to Texas U. and seems to like it fine. My kids are all in school now. Jack is about as usual and certainly does his share of worrying about you. We sent you a box in June but got it back last month. Also sent another in July and guess it will come back. The weather here is very warm for this time of year. We have had good rains. The world series is going on now and the Cardinals won yesterday 2 to 1 which ties them with the St. Louis Browns. We saw the Tech-A. & M. game in San Antonio. A. & M. won 27-13. It was a good game with lots of fist fights going on all the time. Someone stole James car while he was in a cafe in San Antonio but he got it back in about a week unharmed in any way. It was found out at Ft. Sam. Its hard to write to you. There is so much I'd like to say....like keep your chin up etc.
