Dear Mother,

I received a letter from Uncle Tom this afternoon. He wants me to come to see him. I don't know whether I can every [sic] get to or not. I don't want to miss any school. If you are absent one day you get set back a week.

I also received a letter from you a christmas card from Lewis and a letter from [Arky]. The letter and Christmas card were both sent to Farragut.

This week end [sic] I am on the duty section so I will not get liberty. Will probably have several guard dutys [sic] over the week end. [sic] There are a few waves here now. I have been over at the ship service talking to some of them.

I haven't much to say so I will end.
