Dear Mother,

Your letter of the 19th came today. The package came also just in time today. Tomorrow afternoon I am going to town so I will take the things in for Jean. Thanks so much for them mother. The candy was in good shape. Jean is going to be so glad to have the things I am sure.

[page 2] Lucille is getting along all right by her letter today.

It will be all right [sic] if you just send a fountain pen something like the one I have. Jackie's £96 includes his sea pay without anything taken out for insurance or anything.

Don't worry about me going to the Pacific before I come home. The Navy has a lot of work to do over her [sic] after its [sic] over even. Yes I flew up to Whales to do some work.
