Dear Mama,

I received your card this this morning.

I passed structures with a 73 average and below 70 is failing. We start hydrolic today.

I had a tetous and a yellow fever shot this morning. My fth left arm is sore.

I went to Church yesterday morning and the show in the afternoon. I found that Mrs. Reats Sun Night and she asked me to dinner next Sunday. It seems everyone here knows the De Jean's.

Do you remember the Cottons that used to live in Clarence's place. The youngest boy that I used to go to school with is here. He said that that Mr. Wilson who runs the windchang shop by the Ideal Laundry has a boy here.

The boy. A said there was going to be 24,000 here in a few weeks.

We have a new Captain. He is the third the 393 S.S. has had since I've been here but we still have the same old gippy 1st Sergeant. I wish they would kick him out.

Is the fencing finished yet?
What the new cat's name? Did you get

my class? Is there many new people
at the church? I weigh 146 pound. I
weighed 131 when I came here. I bought
two picture post cards but I don't have
any 1¢ stamp yet. I sending a snap shot
of me and the mug that stays next to

from Miss.
