Aug. 14, 1942

Dear Daddy,

I got payed today for last month. I drew \$65.20. I am sending \$20.00 home. I would send more but I don't know when I will get payed again.

We are suppose to leave here in about two weeks. I thank [sic] we will go to Washington and pick up more men but I don't thank [sic] we will stay there long. We may go back last after we leave there but no one knows where we will go. I don't look for a boat ride for for [sic] several months. I sure will be glad to leave here. I will send more next time I get payed and will try to send more.
