Just as I was buying my ticket to come here, Hal ( one of the boys from my company [sic] had seen some of the drafts, they are coming out in a few day [sic]. He saw my name on the Aviation Machinist's Mate list. I know where it is going and when but I don't think that I should tell you.

How is Betty? Have Julia and Daddy been home [page 2] lately? I wrote Betty a letter last night.

Have you seen Jean anywere [sic]?

Tonight here at the U.S.O. I think they are going to have a dance.

This will probably be my last time in town. Although, I could go some more because it will be several days before I leave.

Remember what I [illegible deletion] said in other letters. [illegible deletion] I will need to find out where some of our kinfolk live in Oklahoma.
