

July 16, 1944

Dear Mother,

Today being Sunday there is no mail but I did not get a letter from Mr. Sanders yesterday so I got it today.

I wrote to Betty and ask her to tell you to send me a good fountain pen as I lost my other one. I want a sheafers [sic].

Now I am working on a different ground crew for awhile [sic]. I can't tell you the reason though.

Have you ever received the other cards and the picture. [sic] I also sent you another picture of Jean and myself not very [page 2] long ago. We have not taken the roll of films as Jean and I have not been together on a nice day. Saturday will be the next time I see her. I doubt if we get to take them then as she won't be home until about 7:30.

How is everything at home? Have you got over your cold yet? I hope that you are feeling better at least. Tell everyone hello for me.

I am going to write to Mr. Sanders no [sic] so I will close for this time.
