The mail has not been put up today so I do not know whether I will receive any letters or not. I have a watch tonight and won't be able to write you then so I am writing now. Yesterday the only letter that I received was from Jean Lewis. I had seen her since it was written though.

For the past couple of days we have not had any rain but the sun has not been very bright either.
