I wrote Robert a letter but I didn't know a thing to tell him. I may send my Bible and civil shoes home before I leave

here. If I do I will get a Testament
that won't take up so much space.
Keep my shoes because I may go
some place where I can wear them
and send for them. I won't send
them until just before I leave
if I do them.

I put a picture in that
other letter after I had licked
the envelop and didn't have
time to say anything about
it. You can see the Biloxi
Light house in the background.

I was standing on the seawall.
I was going to borrow a camera
and take some pictures while
I'm here but they made everyone
send their cameras home. There
isn't room for them when
they get shipped out.

Do you'll go to the meeting
much? How is the preacher? Is
there many attending? Who sat
in my seat Sunday? What
kind of field is that one they
are going to haul back home
and when is it going to be
finished. I wish I could go
to a training field somewhere.

It has been cloudy here for
the last two days but it hasn't
rained for a couple of weeks.
