Could you tell me how much money I have now and how many war bonds I have [sic]. Are the bonds comming [sic] regular?

I haven't got a paper in several days now.

I got to stop now because I can't think of any news.

Try to get Mary some shoes if you can. The English and American sizes are not the same. Use some of my money.
