

Aug. 2, 1943

Dear Mama,

I received your letter dated July 8 yesterday. It wa the first I had got in about two weeks.

I tried for half an hour to write J.R. but I couldn't think of any thang [sic] to say so I just stopped. You asked about eggs and milk well we have both but they are powdered and not very good.

I got to church at the chape [sic] every Sunday. The chaplain is a little short major named Appelton.

I went to town last night and went to a band concert down in the pack but it wasn't very good.

We have Winter, Spring, Summer and Fall ever week.

I have saved about \$120.00 the last eaight [sic] months besides what I sent home. I have it in the safe at the Red Cross Club.

Some of the fellows are getting seven day furloughs but I don't think I will try to get one yet.

Well I got to stop now and go to bed.
